ACETAMINOPHEN (Age 14 months – 4 years) - Medication Standing Order

2024 - 2025 School Year

No standing order medication can be administered to a student **without** the parent/guardian written permission except for emergency treatment for anaphylaxis or allergic reactions and/or opioid overdose. This Standing order is to be used at the discretion of the school nurse for a student **awaiting parent pickup** and presents with a **temperature >102**.
