Personal Items: Please Label

- 1 LARGE Backpack -(junior/kids sized do not suit our needs/supplies)
- 3 Kippot (required for boys, encouraged for girls) Cap-style is recommended. Please try to avoid kippot where clips are needed
 - o Can order awesome *kippot* from <u>https://www.kidskippot.com/</u>
- A complete change of clothes in a labeled bag (to be left at school in your child's cubby)
- 1 reusable water bottle
- 2 sets of OVER THE HEAD headphones (not Bluetooth)- not fancy ones- any cheap wired headphones will do! (one is for classroom use and one is for Hebrew)

Shared Items: Labeling Unnecessary

- o 1 box of Crayola washable markers (10 count, Thick and Thin)
- o 1 box of Crayola colored pencils (24 count or more)
- o 1 (24 pack) pack of pencils (preferably Ticonderoga or Dixon they have the best erasers)
