



## **Music Teacher**

Responsibilities of this part-time position (approximately 12 hours per week) include teaching Music classes to students 2 years old through eighth grade and collaborating with the Unified Arts Team to develop the school's music curriculum. This curriculum should include engaging with students using classroom instruments, songs, and dance, introducing students to basic music theory, and singing. The music teacher will design and maintain a dynamic, bright, and inviting classroom space. Above all else, the music teacher is responsible for fostering a love and appreciation of musicianship within all students.
